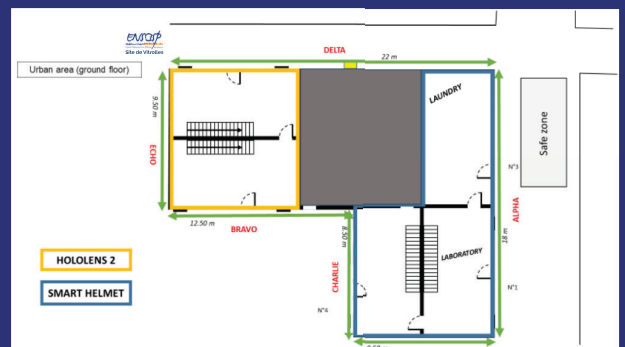

SCENARIO:

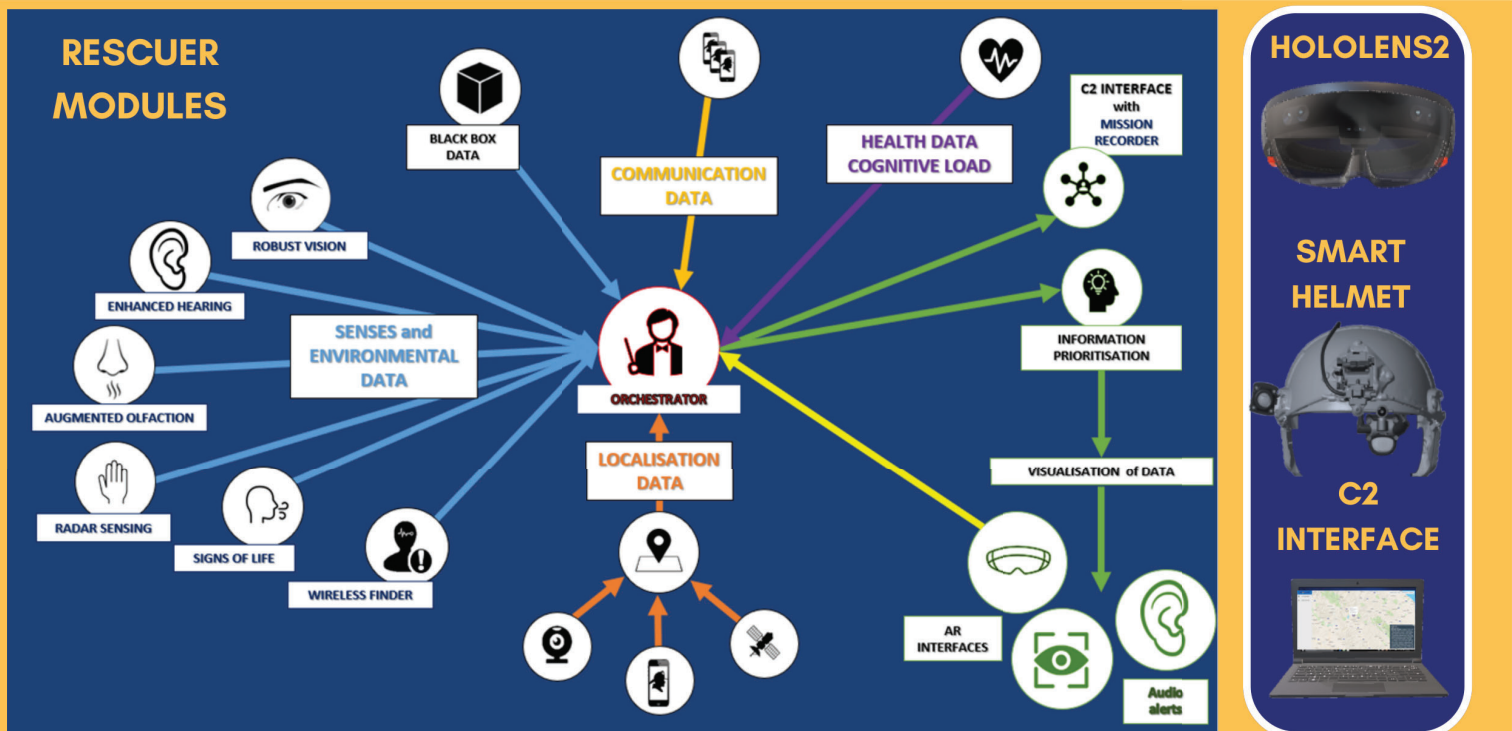
A fire has started in a building which hosts an hotel, a laundry and a laboratory. Electricity has been cut off in the building and smoke is filling both the laundry and the laboratory, where dangerous goods are stored. No smoke nor darkness in the hotel, but cases of people feeling ill have been reported. Two teams are sent to carry out reconnaissance inside the building after the fire has been extinguished:

- one team equipped with **RESCUER HoloLens2 Subsystem**
- one team equipped with **the RESCUER Smart Helmet Subsystem**

For both subsystems, the incident commander observes the status of the team via the C2 interface
